1876

Mr Mick's father - J.H. Knappstein arrived in South Australia

1894

J. H. Knappstein and 3 others purchase 7 Dominic St, Clare to make wine

1895

The Stanley Wine Company opened at 7 Dominic St, Clare

1911

Mr Mick's father gains total control of the company

1975

Mr Mick appoints Tim Adams as apprentice winemaker

1971

Stanley Wine Company is taken over by H J Heinz

1962

Mr Mick becomes Managing Director

1919

Mr Mick's father, J. H. Knappstein died

1976

Knappstein family sells remaining share, but Mr Mick stays at the winery

1982

Tim Adams under the guidance of Mr Mick was appointed winemaker

1985

Mr Mick retired after 57 years at the winery

1985

Adams and Wray partnership formed

2011

Mr Mick's Winery, Cellar Door and Kitchen officially opens

2010

Tim Adams and Pam Goldsack purchase 7 Dominic St, Clare

1987

Adams & Wray partnership dissolves and Tim Adams Wines founded

1986

Tim leaves Leasingham and launches Adams & Wray label
